II	High school diploma, General Equivalency Diploma (GED), or equivalent educational credential acceptable to the Director.	2 years Experience in Facility Operation
III	High school diploma, General Equivalency Diploma (GED), or equivalent educational credential acceptable to the Director.	3 years Experience in Facility Operation
IV	High school diploma, General Equivalency Diploma (GED), or equivalent educational credential acceptable to the Director.	4 years Experience in Facility Operation
V	High school diploma, General Equivalency Diploma (GED), or equivalent educational credential acceptable to the Director.	5 years Experience in Facility Operation

Education may be substituted for experience as follows:

- (i) a technical school or college certificate may equate to not more than 6 months;
- (ii) a two-year associate's degree may equate to not more than to 1 year;
- (iii) a four-year bachelor's degree may equate to not more than 2 years;
- (iv) a master's degree may equate to not more than 3 years

Individuals new to a particular type of license who meet Rule 4-1 requirements but have not yet acquired the examination and experience credentials required to obtain a full license under Part 4 for the grade of license sought, may be issued a provisional license for the grade of license sought to facilitate further professional training.
